

Welcome to the *Film & TV Workshop*.

Monday 27 – Friday 31 July · The Grammar School at Leeds · Ages 5–18 · Younger Company (5–8) & Older Company (9–18)

This week, your child steps into the world of Oz — and in front of the camera. Over five days they'll train the way screen actors train, rehearse in daily blocks with notes, and finish the week on a real film set with a professional crew.

What they'll develop

- **Acting for film and television** — close-ups, reaction shots, hitting marks, and the difference between stage and screen
- **Camera technique** — tracking shots, slow motion, group formations and on-screen performance
- **Music video** — choreography learned, rehearsed and filmed in music-video style
- **Self-tape craft** — the audition skill every young performer now needs
- **Confidence, creativity and teamwork** — built through ensemble work all week

The shape of the week

Monday starts with scene allocations and our **Glinda vs Elphaba Screen Acting Masterclass**. Tuesday to Thursday build technique and rehearse scene blocks, with workshops in make-up, continuity and self-tape, a music video day, and a guest artist workshop and Q&A. Friday is **filming day**: costume and make-up in the morning, then a professional crew films acting scenes and music sequences on our purpose-built set. We close with craft awards.

What your child keeps

Professionally filmed and edited footage of their scenes and music sequences, delivered by private link after the week — plus a week of progress notes on presence, listening, collaboration and voice.

Make it count for longer: add a professional **Headshot Mini Session** or the **Showreel Package** (their strongest moments cut to a personal 60–90 second reel) at booking or on Monday morning.

Whether they're a complete beginner or already love performing, this week is the place to learn, create and shine on screen. We can't wait to welcome them.
